

MEMORIAL LIBRARY MEETING ROOM
JANUARY 5, 2026

Minutes of the reorganization meeting of Shinglehouse Borough Council held on January 5, 2026 in the Memorial Library meeting room. Council present, Mr. Church, Mr. Donovan, Mr. Welty, Mr. Perrin, Mr. Milliken, Ms. McKean and Mayor McKean.

Mayor McKean called the meeting to order. Pledge of Allegiance was said. New council members – Mr. Donovan, Mr. Welty, were sworn in by Mayor McKean.

Nominations for President were made. Mr. Church was nominated. Nominations were closed. Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Perrin to elect Mr. Church as President of Borough Council. Unanimously carried.

Meeting was turned over to newly elected President Church.

Nominations for Vice-President were made. Mr. Resig was nominated. Nominations were closed. Motion was made by Mr. Perrin and seconded by Mr. Donovan to elect Mr. Resig as Vice-president of Borough Council. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Church and seconded by Mr. Mr. Donovan to appoint Ms. McKean as president pro-tem. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Perrin to appoint Tina Payne as secretary-treasury for Shinglehouse Borough. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Perrin and seconded by Mr. Donovan to appoint Richard Brown with Meyer, Wagner, Brown and Kraus as borough solicitor. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Perrin to appoint Andrew Bean as Supt. of Public Works. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Perrin and seconded by Ms. McKean to appoint Herbert, Rowland and Grubic as borough engineers. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Milliken to appoint Roger Bickleman as sewage enforcement officer and Terry Myers as alternate sewage enforcement officer. Unanimously carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Milliken to appoint Bradley Buchholz as chief of police. Unanimously carried.
