

MEMORIAL LIBRARY MEETING ROOM

May 12,2026

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of Shinglehouse Borough Council held in the Municipal Building meeting room on May 12,2026.

Council present: Pres. Barry Church, Mr. Resig. Ms. Mckean, Nr. Welty Mr.Perrin , Mr.Milliken Mayor McKean, and Mr. Donovan and also Andrew Bean.

Meeting was called to order by Pres. Church. Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag was said. Motion by Mr.Perrin seconded by Mr. Donovan to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Unanimously carried.

Guests: Mr. Carslon from DCNR and Clara Township supervisor, Jake Wilde discussed Shinglehouse Borough opting into the opening of borough streets for NRAT COG for ATV's and UTV's to have access to local business's. Mr. Wilde stated Sharon township passed an ATV ordinance for connecting trails as well from their streets. Mr. Carlson from DCNR discussed benefits of bringing more income for business's from people being able to ride and access our borough streets along with dust control. Council stated the brough only has one street Low Street that would benefit from any funding on dust control. Council also stated the borough is surrounded by state road and not legal for ATVS and UTVs to travel state roads at this time and council expressed the concern and safety of the borough residents. Clara Township Supervisor, Jake Wilde stated that Penndot is receptive and would open the state roads in the borough if the brough passed an ordinance. Council advised if they can provide borough secretary and council members with a contact information for a supervisor for Penndot and have Penndot come to a monthly council meeting stating they would open up State Roads in the borough first we would revisit the discussion. Council has tabled the ATV UTV ordinance. Jenny Clarke discussed her plans for property sunroom small greenery shed and updated progress on her water repair. Arbita Meacham discussed concern with lack of recycling waste management within the borough and presented a couple waste management ideas. Council advised Mrs. Meacham to email borough secretary any educational ideas and secretary would post on the borough website to start somewhere small first. One idea is Compositing food waste.

Public Works Report: Andrew Bean reported Suite-Kote came in and crack filled and slurry sealed roads. Started working on park trails. Have received compliments on the little league fields. WWTP upgrade is moving along. Waiting on ERB to review plans for a couple changes to continue on. Repaired few things on Manley Street. Did some cold patching around town.

Hunter Access program at the Cole Lot renewal. Borough council opted into Tier 2 for open to public hunting. Public will have to register online annually to hunt the Cole Lot property on the game commission website. Building assessment permits for Jenny Clarke, Michale Hunt and Richard Demmon. Motion was made by Mr. Milliken and seconded by Mr. Perrin for approval of building assessment permits. Unanimously carried.

Committee Reports: Mr. Milliken stated a few boards need replaced in Pavillion No.03.

New Business: Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Perrin to approve Pennvest Payment request No.13 for funding number 77127 in the amount of \$24,474.50 and includes HRG fees only. Unanimously carried. Mr. Church abstained. Motion was made by Mr. Milliken and seconded by Mr. Perrin to approve Pennvest payment request No.13 funding number 71487 in the amount of \$393,253.34 includes Pennvest related interests costs and construction costs. Unanimously carried. Mr. Church abstained. Motion was made by Mr. Perrin and seconded by Ms. Mckean to approve pay app No.09 for H&K GC in the amount of \$345,006.00. Pay app No. 04 Daev Kronewetter EC in the amount of \$43,560.51 for Dave Unanimously carried. Mr. Barry Church abstained.
